WEST HIGHLAND WAY

One of the the most popular hiking trails in the world, the West Highland Way covers the ground reaching from Milngavie, on the outskirts of Glasgow, right through to Fort William allowing you to acquaint yourself with the stunning Scottish Highlands. ROB ROY WAY

Opened in 2002, the Rob Roy Way crosses the Highland Boundary Fault, a geological divide where the Highlands meet the Lowlands. Named after the famous Scottish folk hero of the late 17th and early 18th century, Rob Roy MacGregor, the trail follows many of the tracks and paths that Rob Roy may have used while working as a cattle breeder, lived as a clansman, and fought as a rebel.
