CAMINO FRANCES

Experience walking the final and most popular section of the Camino Frances trail which in turn is the most celebrated trail of the famous Camino de Santiago pilgrim paths network. Follow the path of St James to Santiago de Compostela, believed to be the burial site of St James the apostle. Experience beautiful landscapes, charming little towns and the local culture that the Camino Frances has to offer! Join the band of friendly pilgrims who have been walking the Camino for over a thousand years ending your hike with a wonderful sense of camaraderie and achievement.



CAMINO PRIMITIVO

Embark on a journey along the Camino Primitivo, the "Original Way," a legendary pilgrimage route to the revered shrine of St James in Santiago de Compostela. This is the very first Camino as walked by King Alfonso II in the 9th century. With every step he took he left behind a legacy of pilgrimage and history. Our curated walking tours focus on the final 100km (62 miles) where the Camino Primitivo joins the Camino Frances at Melide giving walkers a chance to experience the celebrated lively final stages of the more popular route into Santiago.

ST KEVIN'S WAY & GLENDALOUGH

One of Ireland's oldest pilgrimage routes, St Kevin's Way runs through the hills of Wicklow, following in the footsteps the pilgrims who visited his tomb in the glacial valley of Glendalough. The saint founded an early medieval monastery here which became a centre of devotion and learning.
