ROB ROY WAY

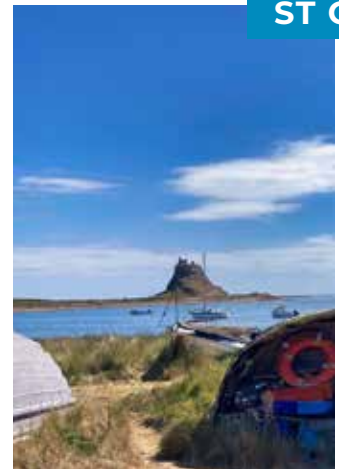
